**Tapeworms:** I would like for my pet to recive a onetime treatment if tapeworms are found at todays procedure. Tapeworms can look like small pieces of rice and are seen stuck under the tail during preparation for surgery and spread via fleas. Yes / No Initial \_\_\_\_\_

**Ear mites:** I would like for my pet to recive a onetime treatment if parasitic mites are found living in the ear canal of my pet at todays procedure. Ear mite dirt looks like coffee grounds packed into the ear canal. They are itchy and can lead to infection and even cause deformity of the ears.
